### **NEW SCHOLARSHIPS**

**CT RollerGirls Cindy Luberto Scholarship** - This is for female athletes who embrace the passion of sports. Awards are \$500 each. Applicant must be an athlete who plays a sport in school or in the community, planning to begin college in the fall, and submit a 250 word essay describing your passion for the sport you play. Applications are available in the guidance office. **All materials are to be submitted by May 18.**

**John J. Kelly Memorial Scholarship** - Any college-bound senior who resides in any public housing or whose family participates in a Section 8 program are eligible to apply. Awards are \$3,500 each. Applicant must provide proof of college acceptance. **Applications are now available in the guidance office and are due June 8.**

**Susan C. Davis Memorial Scholarship** - for any senior plan to major in education leading to a degree/career in the teaching profession. Awards are \$500 each. Scholarship will be awarded on the basis of academic excellence and financial need. Applications are in the scholarship drawer and the **deadline date is Friday, May 11.**

**NFTE Scholarship** – This is a \$5,000 scholarship for senior entrepreneurs. Applicant must be enrolled in a NFTE entrepreneurship program, must have participated in one of their citywide and/or regional business plan competitions, must have a minimum GPA of 3.0, must plan to begin college this fall and must demonstrate leadership/entrepreneur qualities. Applications are in the scholarship drawer. Hurry – **applications must be postmarked by May 4<sup>th</sup>.**

### **PREVIOUSLY RELEASED**

**HFSS Scholarship** – Available to seniors who are Hartford residents planning to attend a post-secondary institution this fall. Awards will be based on financial need, and academic achievement.


**Mass Mutual Scholars Program** – Open to students of African-American, Asian/Pacific Islander or Hispanic descent. Must show proof of citizenship or legal permanent resident, must have at least a 3.0 GPA, and must plan to begin college this fall. Preference will be given to students who are interested in pursuing a career in the insurance and financial services industry. Applications can only be completed on-line at [www.act.org/massmutual](http://www.act.org/massmutual). Students can win up to \$5,000. **May 4 is the last day to apply.**

**NECBAC Scholarship** – The New England Counselors of Color Bridging Access to College Organization will award book scholarships to seniors who plan to attend one of the NECBAC affiliated schools (list included with application). Applications are now available in the guidance office. **Completed applications must be postmarked by May 15.**

**West Hartford Music and Art Club Scholarship** – Seniors who have received acceptance to an art school or college are eligible to apply. A one-time \$1,500 scholarship will be awarded. Applicant must plan to major in art studies and must submit pieces of your artwork. **May 4 is the deadline date.**

**Karen Finder Scholarship** – This is open to all SMSA seniors who plan to attend college, who are involved in school and community activities and who has followed the four core beliefs. The award is \$1,500. Applications are available in the guidance office. **April 27 is the last day to submit applications.**

**SHPE-CT Scholarship** – The Society of Hispanic Professional Engineers of CT will award scholarships to seniors of Hispanic descent who plan to study in any STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics) related field. Applicant must have at least a 2.8 GPA and plan to begin college (2 or 4-year) by fall 2012. **Completed apps must be mailed by May 1.**



**Kline Family Community Service Scholarship** – Students who plan to attend UCONN in the fall are eligible to apply. No additional requirements outlined. Awards will be based on letters of recommendation, essay, and extra-curricular involvement in both school and in the community. Applications are available in the guidance office. **April 25 is the deadline date.**

**Dorothy Hofmann Pembroke** – For female students who have or plan on applying to Brown University. Awards are based on academic achievement, extra-curricular, community involvement, and financial need. Scholarship will cover full or part of tuition, room, board and books. **Completed applications must be mailed by May 15, 2012.**

**Starwood Scholarship** – Starwood Teens will again awards scholarships to college-bound seniors. Applicants must write a 400-600 word essay answering three questions, i.e. “describe the greatest thing you did to help your community; describe the biggest obstacle you persevered in; and your college plans/major.” Information sheets are available in the guidance office. **All documentation must be mailed prior to May 26.**

**CSU System Foundation Scholarships** – Students who will attend a Conn. State University (CCSU, WCSU, SCSU, ECSU) in the fall of 2012 and who is a child of a member of the CT State Building and Trades Union are eligible to apply. Applicant must have at least a 2.75 GPA and must demonstrate financial need. Applications are available in the guidance office. **Completed applications must be mailed no later than April 30<sup>th</sup>.**

**Milton Fisher** – This is an innovation and creativity scholarship, which rewards and encourages creative problem solving. Applicant must plan to attend a college in the fall of 2012. Applications are now available in the guidance office. Awards range between \$1,000 and \$20,000. **Scholarship applications are due by April 30, 2012.**

**AFSA Scholarship Contest** – The American Fire Sprinkler Association awards scholarship to seniors who successfully complete their on-line test (open book). Awards are \$2,000 each. Information sheets are available in the guidance office. **Information must be submitted no later than August 2012.** Log on to [www.afsascholarship.org/hsinformation.html](http://www.afsascholarship.org/hsinformation.html) to complete the application.
